**Is her name Alice?**



Yes, her name is Alice.

Alice is married and she has three children.

**Is she single or married?**

She is not single. Alice is not a single woman. She is married.

**Does she have any children?**

Yes, she does. She has three children.

**How many children has she got?**

3 children. She has got three children.

**Has she got one child?**

No, she hasn't. She hasn't got only one child. She has got three children.

**Does she have 17 children?**

No, she doesn't. She doesn't have 17 children. She has 3 children.

Alice is a nice person. She has got a few friends. They are nice people too.

**Is Alice a nice person?**

Yes, she is. She is a nice person. She is very kind.

**Has she got a lot of friends?**

No, she hasn't. She hasn't got a lot of friends. She has got a few friends.

**Does she have 27 friends?**

No, she doesn't. She doesn't have 27 friends. She has a few friends. She has 3-5 or 4-6 friends.

**Does she have a few friends?**

Yes she does. She has a few friends.

**Are her friends bad people?**

No, they aren't. They are not bad people. They are nice people.

**Are they good people?**



Yes they are. They are very good people. They are nice and kind people.

She has a big garden.

**How many gardens does she have?**

One garden. She has only one garden.

**Does she have 24 gardens?**

No, she doesn't. She doesn't have 24 gardens. She has only one garden.

**Does she have a garden?**

Yes, she does. She has a garden.

**Is it a small garden?**

No, it isn't. It is not a small garden. It is a big garden. Alice has a big garden.

**What is there in the garden?**

A table. There is a table in the garden.

**Is there a car in the garden?**

No, there isn't. There is not a car in the garden. There is a table in the garden.

**Are there 3 tables in the garden?**

No, there aren't. There are not 3 tables in the garden.

**How many tables are there?**

One table. There is a table in the garden. There is only one table in the garden.

**Is there a small table in the garden?**

No, there isn't. There is not a small table. There is a big table in the garden.

**Is it a small table?**

No, it isn't. It is not a small table. It is a big table. The table is not small. It is very big.

There are 3 boxes under the table.

**How many boxes are there under the table?**

3 boxes. There are 3 boxes under the table.



**Are there 8 boxes?**

No, there aren't. There are not 8 boxes. There are 3 boxes.

**Is there one box under the table?**

No, there isn't. There is not one box. There are 3 boxes under the table.

**Are the boxes empty?**

No, they aren't. They are not empty. The boxes are not empty.

**What is there in the boxes?**

There are 36 cats in the boxes.

**How many cats are there in the boxes?**

36 cats. There are 36 cats in the boxes.

**Are there 11 cats in the boxes?**

No, there aren't. There aren't 11 cats. There are 36 cats in the boxes.

**Is there one cat?**

No, there isn't. There isn't one cat. There are 36 cats.

**How many cats are there in per boxes?**

12 cats. There are 12 cats in per box under the table.

**Are there 3 cats in per box?**

No, there aren't. There aren't 3 cats in per box.

**Are there 12 cats in per box?**

Yes there are. There are 12 cats in per box.

These 36 cats are very poor. They have little Money. They have only 2 dollars each.

**Are these cats rich?**

No, they aren't. They are not rich. They are poor. They have only 2 dollars each.

**How much Money do each cats have?**

Two dollars. They have only 2 dollars each.



**How much Money do these cats have total?**

72 dollars. They have 72 dollars total.

**Do they have 36 dollars?**

No, they don't. They don't have 36 dollars. They have 72 dollars.

Also there is a small basket on the table.

**Is there a bicycle on the table?**

No, there isn't. There is not a bicycle on the table. There is a basket on the table.

**What is there?**

A basket. A small basket. There is a small basket.

**Where is the small basket? Where is it?**

On the table. It is on the table.

**Is it under the table?**

No, it isn't. It isn't under the table. It is on the table.

**Is there a big basket on the table?**

No, there isn't. There is not a big basket on the table. There is a small basket on the table.  
The basket is small.

**How many baskets are there?**

One basket. There is only one basket.

**Are there 3 baskets on the table?**

No, there aren't. There aren't 3 baskets. There is one basket on the table.

**What is there in the basket?**

A monkey. There is a monkey in the basket.

**Is there a rabbit in the basket?**

No, there isn't. There isn't a rabbit in the basket. There is a monkey in the basket.

**Where is the monkey? Is the monkey out of the basket?**



No, It isn't. It is not out of the basket. It is in the basket.

**How many monkeys are there in the basket?**

One monkey. There is one monkey in the basket?

**Are there 5 monkeys in the basket?**

No, there aren't. There aren't 5 monkeys. There is only one monkey in the basket.

**Is the monkey poor, or rich?**

The monkey is rich. He has lots of Money.

**How much money does he have?**

27 million dollars. He has 27 million dollars.

Does he have 8 million dollars?

No he doesn't. He doesn't have 8 million dollars. He has 27 million dollars. He is very rich.
